

Online Proctored Examination Instructions

Section A

1. **Identity Verification:**

Before the commencement of the examination, please display your admit card to the online proctor by holding it at an appropriate distance from the camera without obstructing camera visibility.

2. **Candidate Authentication:**

Your identity will be verified by the online proctor based on the ID document submitted during your entrance examination application.

3. **Environment Check (Mandatory):**

Before the start of the examination, the candidate must show the online proctor, using the laptop camera, that:

- No one else is present in the room, and
- The table is clear and does not contain any additional device, book, notes, or any other unauthorized material.

4. **Malpractice & Suspicious Activity:**

If any suspicious activity or malpractice is observed/detected, your examination will be immediately cancelled, and your performance will be treated as null and void.

You will receive on-screen notifications for suspicious behavior detected either by AI or by the human proctor monitoring you.

The proctor will issue three warnings before cancelling the exam and marking it as null and void.

Section B

High-Severity Malpractices (Zero Tolerance)

The following actions are strictly prohibited:

Suspicious Activities

- Moving away from the exam screen.
- Human conversation during the exam.
- Hiding or covering the camera.
- Presence of another face in the camera view.
- Continuous eye or head movement.
- Repeated attempts to exit the exam screen.
- Trying to open an internet browser.
- Screen sharing or screen mirroring.
- Talking to yourself or others.

Malpractice Activities

- Using any device during the exam (mobile phone, earphones, earbuds, smartwatches, etc.).
- Using any physical materials (books, notes, printed materials, newspapers, etc.).
- Impersonation of the candidate.
- Presence of any additional person in the examination area.
- Receiving prompts or assistance for answers from any source.

Section C

Note (for Logical Reasoning & Quantitative Aptitude Sections):

If you need to perform rough calculations:

- Show both sides of the blank sheet of paper to the proctor before starting, by holding it in front of the camera silently.
- After completing your rough work, show the used sheet again to the proctor before submitting your answer.
- Ensure the camera visibility is not blocked while showing the rough work.
